
AstroScope

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Lay Astro-Scope face down, exposing the base, as shown. Using the finger holes, remove the sliding door. A diagram showing which way to insert the 4 D type batteries is located on the sliding door. Replace the sliding door and the batteries will be held in place.



LIGHT SHIELD

For best results form a circle out of the enclosed black fibre board and place around the outer rim of the Astroscope screen.

MIRROR INSTALLATION

Remove the snap fit screen assembly from the dome. Select a mirror and attach it to the motor by pressing it onto the motor shaft. Be sure the shaft sticks firmly into the rubber center of the mirror hub. (We recommend that the planetary nebulizor [mirror M-1] be placed on the top motor and left there to be used in combination with all the other mirrors.) When changing a mirror, a gentle tug will release it from the motor shaft. However, some mirrors may be a little snug. If so, support the motor bracket while removing the mirror in order not to bend the bracket. Then replace the screen assembly.

OPERATING TIPS FOR YOUR

AstroScope

With the batteries and mirrors in place, flick on the lite beam. Note the light adjustment lever behind the neck. Move it in, out, or sideways, until the light on the screen is the brightest. Coordinate the spectre controls to make designs. Move them to the right for the slowest speed, then back toward the "off" position to increase it. Flip the implosion imput lever to peripheral output to reverse one motor for more effects.

Rotate the color modulator for a rainbow of color combinations.

BULB REPLACEMENT

If it ever becomes necessary to replace the bulb, remove the two screws on the door at the back of the neck. Carefully pull out the light adjustment assembly a few inches. Do not jerk the electrical wire! The bulb can now be easily removed from the plastic holder. Push the bulb out of the metal contact clamp and replace it with # 243 miniature screw base lamp. Re-assemble the components, slide the assembly back in and replace the screws.
