

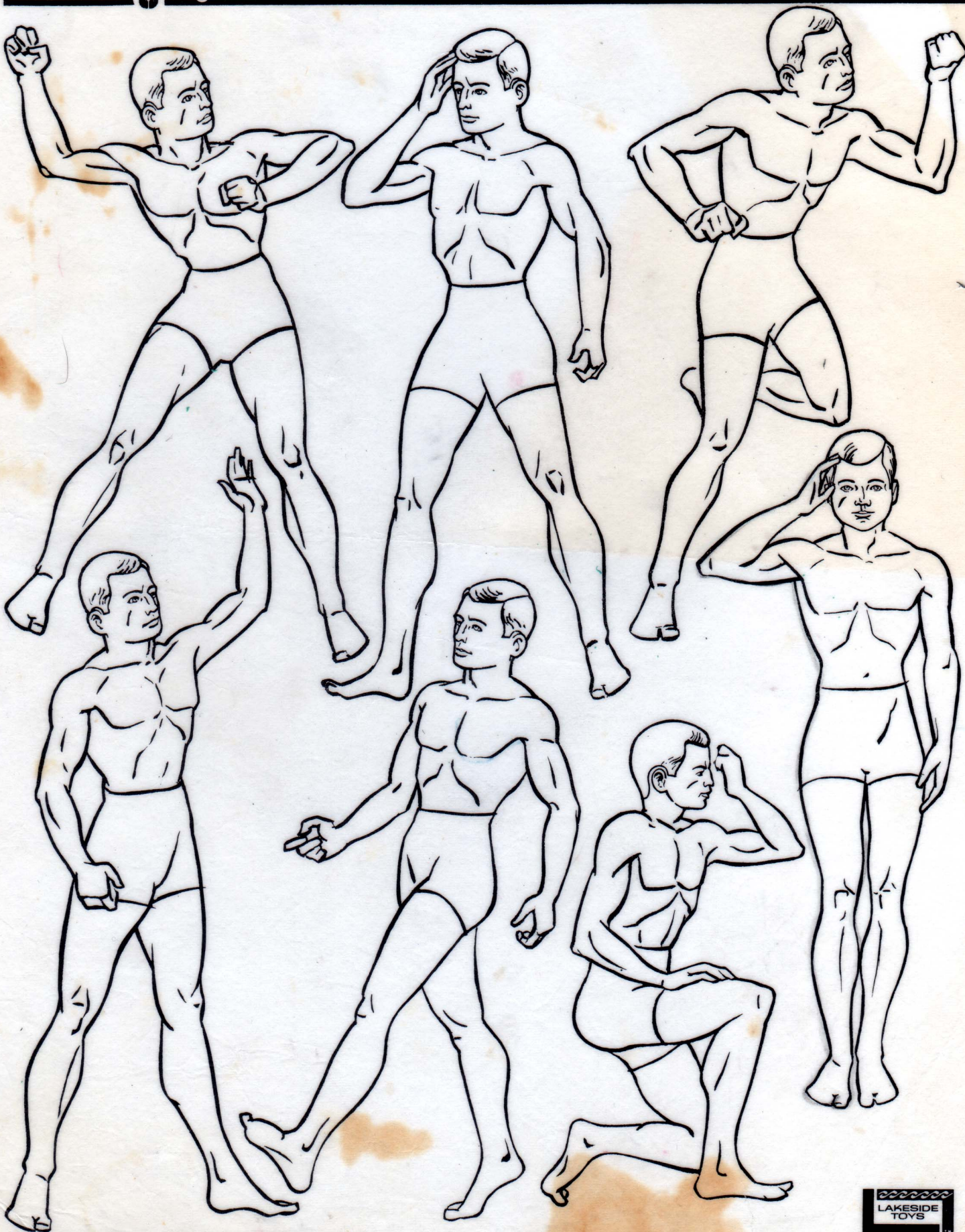
FIGURE GUIDE SHEET

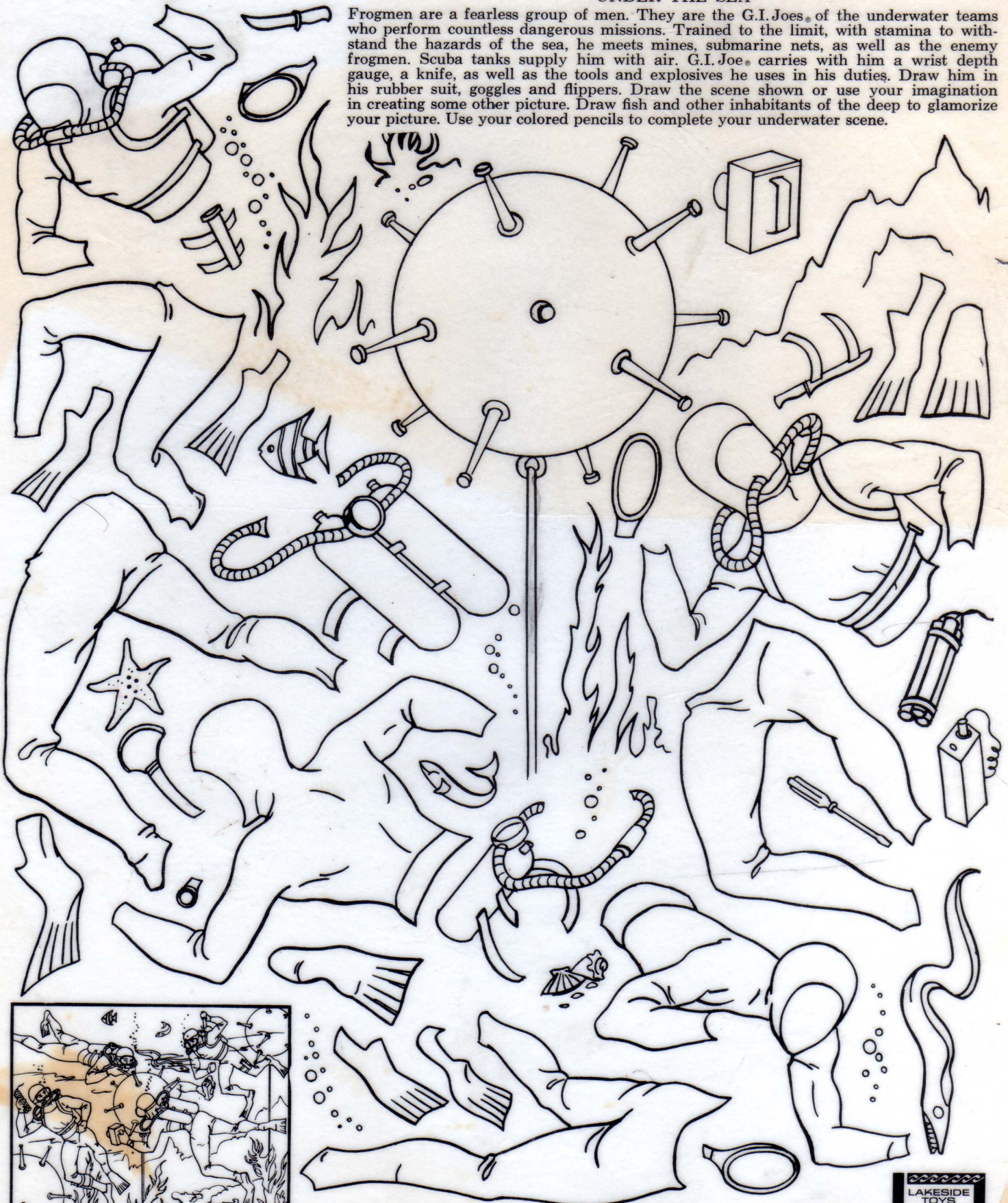

UNDER THE SEA

Frogmen are a fearless group of men. They are the G.I. Joes of the underwater teams who perform countless dangerous missions. Trained to the limit, with stamina to withstand the hazards of the sea, he meets mines, submarine nets, as well as the enemy frogmen. Scuba tanks supply him with air. G.I. Joe carries with him a wrist depth gauge, a knife, as well as the tools and explosives he uses in his duties. Draw him in his rubber suit, goggles and flippers. Draw the scene shown or use your imagination in creating some other picture. Draw fish and other inhabitants of the deep to glamorize your picture. Use your colored pencils to complete your underwater scene.



OBSERVATION POST

This group of G.I. Joes are on observation duty on one side of a river. They are getting information about the enemy's strength and troop positions on the other shore. Are there enemy troops in the building across the river? Is it a command post? The G.I. Joe with the binoculars is probably in command. The man with the telephone is giving information to headquarters so they can add it to the information they already have. Use other sheets for more ideas to add to your drawing. Don't forget camouflage on the men for protection.



HEADQUARTERS

The scene shows a combined operations headquarters in operation. Marines and Air Force personnel are having secret meetings to plan strategy. Both a Military Police and a member of the Shore Patrol are on duty to guard the buildings and grounds. Who is in the jeep that is being stopped by the S.P.? What is the building guarded by the M.P.? Put a name on the door. Draw all the uniforms in their proper colors. Color the flag. Combine this page with other pages to make other scenes.



CRASH AT SEA

When the order comes to "Ditch," much activity takes place on the plane. G.I. Joe knows that every consideration for every kind of emergency has been thought about. The quick inflating rubber boat is equipped with oars, food, a flare gun for signaling, a first aid kit, and a dye that not only aids rescuers to find our friends, but turns away sharks. Draw a dramatic sea rescue scene and use lots of color in the picture. Put in two rafts. Turn over the paper and face one raft the other way. Add ships, planes and equipment from other sheets.
